1. Have a IMCA recognized divers certification – for complete list of certificates recognized reference document IMCA D03/08; [www.imca-int.com](http://www.imca-int.com). Certificates issued under the 'Verification of experienced ACDE surface supplied and bell divers' undertaken by The Ocean Corporation with the approval of IMCA. **ACDE Certificates issued since 1993** - Certificates issued by US training schools which are accredited by the Association of Commercial Diving Educators (ACDE) in respect of training/assessment performed in accordance with US Standard ANSI/ACDE-01-1993 and its successor standard ANSI/ACDE-01-1998. 2. Trainee Air Diving Supervisor - Have demonstrated competence as a commercial diver and have 100 offshore dives logged.
